

Why take a Law School course?

- **It demonstrates initiative and a broad skill set.**
- **Learn how the legal system impacts business.**
- **Learn from the school that revolutionized law by applying economics.**

What should I know about taking a Law School course?

- **The calendars are different:** Winter, spring, and summer breaks often don't match. The good news: Law exams often finish first. Plan ahead at http://www.law.uchicago.edu/calendar/academic-calendar_2008-2009.html
- **You cannot take first-year classes:** Contracts, Torts, Criminal Law, Civil Procedure, Property, and Elements of the Law are off-limits.
- **Seminars might fill up:** Classes that meet after 4 pm are allocated via a lottery. Check the results at <http://www.law.uchicago.edu/academics/registrationlotteryresults.html>.
- **You typically get only one grade:** No weekly problem sets. Typically one in-class or take-home exam. Consider pass/fail grading.
- **Up to six courses count toward the MBA degree.** Tuition is the same; it costs no bid points (but you earn 2,000).
